Promoting positive behaviour, using de-escalation techniques and supporting emotional wellbeing.
- **Safeguarding & Child Protection**
Recognising concerns, following procedures and maintaining a safe learning environment.
- **Literacy & Numeracy Support**
Helping pupils with reading, writing, maths and phonics through targeted interventions.
- **Monitoring & Assessment**
Observing pupil progress, recording outcomes and feeding back to teachers.
- **Communication & Teamwork**
Collaborating with teachers, SENCOs and support staff to meet pupil needs.
- **Professional Conduct & Reflection**
Developing resilience, confidentiality and reflective practice to improve performance.
